1st day - For the smell of the countryside

Centrum Eden


Go to Bystřice nad Pernštejnem for a thematic tour about the life of our ancestors, the castle life of the nobility or about agriculture and farms.

Mitrov Farm

Try the Steak Preparation Course during which you will be able to see the entire farm or enjoy a gourmet experience at the restaurant.

Eco farm Zelené Údolí

This farm is specialized in agrotourism, breeding fish, sheep, cattle, fallow deer and deer and it offers many experiences. You will learn how to feed the sheeps, how to care for their health, how to put them out to pasture, what their life cycles are or you will feed the deers, milk a cow and find out how to make butter and cheese!



2nd day - Geopark Vysočina and Roštejn Castle

Roštejn Castle

The new exhibition at the castle presents forest, hunting and nature. During the tour you will visit the night forest and the animal tracks on the floor will come alive before your eyes. You will experience an encounter with a deer or a bat, crawl through an anthill or try hunting without weapons. The tour is very interactive and therefore suitable for the little ones.

Geopark Vysočina

The stonemasons' paradise stretches from Telč to the highest peak of Vysočina region which is called Javořice. Its dominant feature and heart is Míchova skála - two weathered rock towers about 13 m high. It is said that the last wolf of the Jihlava Peaks was shot in this area in 1829. The symbol of the whole area is the stone tradition because granite was mined here. In Mrákotín you can visit the museum of stonework and the underground.

3rd day - From the castle to the sub-castle

Světlá nad Sázavou Chateau

The exposition offers an interesting view of life at Světlá Chateau in the 1920s and 1930s. The objects of daily life are installed as if the last inhabitants had left the castle a few moments ago. At the same time you will see the furnishings and assortment of a traditional general store with mixed goods and unique objects of crafts that have disappeared.

Glassworks Huť Jakub Tasice

Glassworks Huť Jakub Tasice was founded in 1796. Many historical events of local, regional or world significance have passed by, but the glassworks still stands in its place and commemorates the glorious past, present and future of Czech glassmaking. It is a unique set of historical buildings of mostly industrial character accessible as an exceptionally preserved glass museum. You can also buy glass products from local production and from leading Czech artists.





And if that wasn't enough...

- Panský dvůr Telč a former farm offers a lot of fun for children and adults - play with the animals or conquer the rope obstacles
- Boats and pedal boats on the Štěpnický Pond complement your visit to Telč with a boat ride. The rental is open in July and August depending on the weather
- Svatá Kateřina Riding Station riders can stay at the Resort Svatá Kateřina and benefit from wellness and fitness services and Ayurvedic therapy
- Turistatek Javořice take a break at the farm, taste regional products, pet the animals or stay in pleasant cottages and enjoy a night just a stone's throw from the fairytale Telč
